THE OHIO PRESS NETWORK: LAROSE BREAKS DOWN GOP SENATE DEBATE, DISCUSSES HIS LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

COLUMBUS, Ohio – In a radio interview on 98.9 FM, Ohio Secretary of State and Republican U.S. Senate candidate Frank LaRose discussed his position on various issues the day after the Ohio U.S. Senate debate.

LaRose reiterated his pro-life stance and called for federal action to defund taxpayer support of Planned Parenthood. LaRose also proposed deploying three U.S. military divisions to the Mexican border to enhance border security and called for the classification of cartels as foreign terrorist organizations. He criticized the Biden administration's economic policies, arguing they hurt working-class families, and advocated for more freedom, tax cuts, and streamlined regulations.

LaRose also emphasized parents' rights, opposing government interference in parenting and education. He explained why he is against rules that allow men to compete in women's sports, arguing it undermines the fairness and safety of athletics.
